Late Shri Ram Murti Ji (08.02.1910 - 02.10.1988)

he SRMS Trust was established in the memory of Late Shri Ram Murti Ji, veteran freedom fighter, a true Gandhian, Ex-Parliamentarian and Ex-Minister, U.P. Govt.

Shri Ram Murti Ji was born on February 08, 1910 in a renowned zamindar family from the lineage of Sahu Thakur Dass at village Dhaura of District Bareilly. After attaining the basic education from Bareilly, he completed graduation from Banaras Hindu University and thereafter did Post Graduation and LL.B. from Lucknow University.

Being impressed with the philosophy of Gandhi Ji and inspired by the thoughts of Mahamana Pt. Madam Mohan Malviya he courted arrest while studying in Banaras Hindu University. He took part in all Satyagrahs and Quit India Movement launched by AICC under the mature and dynamic leadership of Gandhi Ji. He was a true Gandhian. He was imprisoned several times during freedom struggle and was sentenced to Kal Kothri for two months.

Shri Ram Murti Ji declined to accept the pension offered to the freedom fighters, since he was of the conviction that whatever he did for the mother land was out of patriotism and not for material gains. In pursuance of the same spirit he donated 30 acres of agricultural land in the Bhoodan Movement of Late Shri Vinoba Bhabhe.

He breathed last on October 02, 1988.

Computer Centre plays a critical role of a learning centre both for the students and faculty. Computer Centre is equipped with latest IBM/HP/Xeon server with over 250 network systems i7/i5/i3 Intel Processor, 2GB/4GB RAM, Memory 500 GB/1 TB Hard Drive, 17"/15" color monitor. The platform is available in Computer Centre - Windows-7, Windows-XP, Unix, Linux (ubantu) and Novell Netware using different softwares like - Oracle, Visual Studio, Photoshop, Illustrator, MATLAB, IBM Rational Rose, Director, C, C++ etc. Computer Centre is equipped with facilities such as: Scanner, Line, Laser and Dot-Matrix Printers. All students are given a personal computer account, e-mail address, network drive, personal space on the Web Server and access to the Internet. Computer Centre is open round the clock.



HEALTH CENTRE

The college maintains a primary health centre where primary medical services are made available to the students in the college campus itself. For tertiary services, SRMS-IMS, an ultra modern, 950 bed, centrally air-conditioned Hospital caters to the medical needs of the students and faculty. Moreover, 24 hours first-aid and ambulance facilities are available within the campus under the supervision of doctors and qualified assistant.

To give students peace of mind and tranquility which they need for better concentration and mental peace, the college has the required infrastructure for Yoga, Pranayam & Meditation.



SPORTS FACILITIES

The college provides facilities to students to pursue a wide range of sports activities on campus. The outdoor facilities include fields for athletics (6 Lane 400 Meters Track field with all accessories), hockey, football and cricket & courts for basketball, volleyball and badminton. College provides excellent indoor facilities for table tennis, badminton, billiards, chess, carrom & pool etc. There is also a separate indoor squash court on college campus.















GUEST HOUSE

The college maintains an air-conditioned guest house within the campus for the stay of individuals visiting the college. The rooms are well furnished with all modern facilities. The college provides the facility of a guest house to the parents of students and official visitors.

To provide a spiritual environment to students, faculties & staff, all of our campuses have separate temples. Radha Mohan Temple of Lord Krishna & Radha and Narmadeshwar Temple of Lord Shiva with Family are in Bareilly and Lucknow campus. Lord Hanuman Temple is also in Lucknow campus.





HOSTELS

Thousands of students across the state are provided with residential facilities on the College Campus, which comes closest to being a home away from home. Separate facilities for boys and girls, caring wardens and all alert security to ensure a pleasant stay and focus on academics. There are 4 Hostels in the college campus- Revati Hostel (for girls), Shri Laxmi Bhushan Varshney Hostel & Er. Subhash Mehra Hostel (for boys) and Boys PG Hostel. These hostel rooms are well furnished. They have separate messes managed by the Students Committee. Hostels have the 24-hour power supply, hot water supply in winters, common rooms with LCD TV & indoor games. Only vegetarian and nutritious foods are served in the hostel mess.



CENTENNIAL AUDITORIUM



The campus has a state-of-the-art fully air conditioned "Shri Ram Murti Smarak Centennial Auditorium". The total seating capacity of the centennial auditorium is 1238 viewer's seats, and a stage for 50 seats. The seating capacity of the balcony is 414 viewer seats. The centennial auditorium is fully media equipped with LCD Projectors and HD Sounds Systems to host International Conferences, seminars, guest lectures, cultural events, etc.

SRMS TRUST: SOCIAL ENDEAVOURS

SRMS Trust has always been progressive and oriented towards the upliftment of under privileged population of the society in the area of health & education. Following are the Social and Charitable Activities of the Trust:

Charitable Health Care Services

SRMS Mobile Telemedicine Bus - It is equipped with basic diagnostic facilities and free pharmacy with video conferencing facility through which specialist doctor at SRMS telemedicine studio provides consultation and prescribes medicines. The bus is vising everyday except Sunday to the rural areas and delivering medical services. This facility was inaugurated by honorable Health Minister of U.P. Shri Siddharth Nath Singh Ji.

SRMS Hospital On Wheel – Mobile hospital is reaching in rural areas with the objective to provide Screening & Treatment facilities at the door step for Blindness, Deafness, Diabetes, T.B., Malnutrition, Hypertension, Cancer & support services for Healthy Mother & Healthy Baby. Free diagnostics, free medicines and consultation of doctors are being provided. This facility was inaugurated by then Honorable Chief Minister of UP.

Telemedicine Centre at village Bhairpura - A Telemedicine Centre has been established in village Baharpura District Bareilly in which the patients are diagnosed by the doctors after video conferencing with specialty and super specialty doctors present in studio of SRMS Hospital, Bareilly. The medicines are also given free of cost.

SRMS Janhit Chikitsa Yojna - The programme was inaugurated on the 4th July, 2009 with an objective to provide free treatment to the patients who are deprived of the treatment due to financial constraints. Under this scheme Trust has provision for selecting 6 patients every day and provide treatment to these patients in its hospital. During the treatment the patients are provided free of cost medicines, consumables, food, investigation and hospitalization. Free medicine distribution worth 1.5 cr annually to 2.25 lakh patients in a year.

SRMS Samudayik Swastha Yojna - It provides provision at Rs. 365/- per year (Rs. 1/- per day) for treatment upto Rs. 50,000/- for the couple in SRMS Hospital. Under One Rupee scheme total registered 20713 till now.

Free Pharmacy at SRMS hospital, providing 150 types of generic ethical medicines and consumables including 5th generation antibiotics to OPD and IPD patients. Around 500 + patients take medicines every day. 2 free other pharmacy shops are being run by SRMS Trust Village Dhaura Tanda, Bareilly and another is at N4, Rampur Garden, Bareilly.

Cataract Screening and operation programme - The Trust has undertaken this programme since the 2nd October 2002. Till date the Trust has organized 700+ Camps for selection of patients having cataract. More than 20000 patients have been successfully operated free of cost by the team of SRMS Doctors.

Provision of 400 Free Beds in SRMS Hospital -The Trust has provision for 400 Beds in SRMS Hospital whereby the patient is not charged any amount for Bed, Consultation Fee, Surgical Charges and O.T. Charges in General Ward.

Rural Health Camp - The Trust organizes Rural & Urban Health Camps throughout the year and sends specialty and super specialty doctors in various medically backward areas for providing health care services. In these camps the Trust distributes free medicines and also provides free diagnostic services like ECG, Blood sugar and other basic Blood investigations. Till date the Trust has organized more than 500+ Camps and examined over 50000 patients.

Government Health Programmes / **Schemes** - The Trust is also running various Govt. Sponsored Health Programmes in its Hospital, such as – Revised National Tuberculosis Programme (DOTS), Janani Suraksha Yojanaana, Free Sterilization, Family Planning & Welfare Programmes, Vaccination Programme, ICTC Centre for AIDS and PMJAY.

Community Health Camp - The Trust regularly organizes community health camps in association with Rotary Club Bareilly (West) in Mudia Ahamad Nagar, Rithora, Bareilly. Last over 20 year.

Cochlear Implant Program - SRMS trust has aided to start 'Cochlear Implant' program which is not available as of yet in western UP with the help of Department of ENT and Head & Neck Surgery of Shri Ram Murti Smarak Institute of Medical Sciences, Bareilly. This program is helping and treating impaired children at a low cost.

ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION

Today, the biggest challenge faced by the humanity around the world is environmental protection. Keeping this in mind, efforts are underway at various levels to save the environment throughout the world. Efforts are on to conserve the environment through movements, treaties etc. The Trust has also accepted the challenge of environmental protection and has contributed to save the environment in the following ways.

Tree Plantation

Plantation is the only and most accurate criterion for purification and strengthening of the environment. Trees not only purify the air but also fulfill the shortage of vital air. Soil erosion, air pollution, etc. are checked through plantation. The Trust has discharged its duty by imposing more than 10,000 plants so far for its pledge of environmental protection.

Organic Farming



Mostly fertilizers are used for high yield of crops in the fields. This improves yield, but also reduces fertile capacity of soil. Apart from this vegetables produced using fertilizers get poisonous. Which can cause various types of fatal diseases. In view of this, the Trust decided to undertake organic farming. under which crops are being grown using less fertilizers and maximum use of organic manure. So far, about 17 tonnes of tomatoes, 1 ton of okra, 5 tonnes of brinjal, cabbage, wheat and paddy have been successfully produced through organic farming.



Use of Renewable Energy

The Trust has focused a lot on the use of renewable energy in its institutions. For this, the trust has installed solar panels on the buildings of its various institutions. Various types of work such as heating water, lighting in the dark, etc. are being done well by the electricity generated through solar panels.

Rain Water Harvesting

We all use water a lot for our daily needs. Apart from this, water is also highly used in factories. The main source of this water supply is ground water. The level of ground water is continuously decreasing. The Trust has made more than 100 rainwater harvesting sites in its various institutions with serious consideration on this issue. By which control of water level is done by bringing the water back to the ground water in the rainy season.

The Trust has decided that plastic should be used at least in the Trust premises. Many awareness campaigns have been conducted by the Trust regarding the problems of excessive use of plastic. A rule has also been made by the trust on plastic ban in the campus. The main objective of which is to keep the trust premises plastic-free and green.

IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS

CHANGE OF BRANCH

The branch of study once allocated by the University shall not be changed; however, such changes may be allowed against vacant seats at the beginning of 2nd year, on the basis of merit in the B.Tech. 1st year examination result (without any back and grace marks).

Change of branch may be allowed against the vacant seats in the following two stages:

- A. i. In the 1st year, branch change should be completed within 10 days of the last date of a d mission to the B.Tech., 1st Semester, strictly on the basis of combined general merit of entrance examination on vacant seats.
 - ii. After change of branch, number of students in branches shall neither increase over the intake approved by A.I.C.T.E. nor decrease below 75% of intake approved by A.I.C.T.E.
- B. In the 2nd year (3rd semester) Branch Change should be completed according to the following criteria:
 - i. Branch change at the college level shall be carried out by the Director / Principal of the college.
 - ii. Facility of Branch Change at the 2nd year (3rd Semester) level shall be available only to meritorious students and shall not be considered as a matter of right.
 - iii. Branch Change is permitted in the beginning of the 3rd Semester (2nd year) only.
 - iv. For the purpose of branch change, the "prescribed intake" shall be the intake prescribed by AICTE for the previous academic session including 10% intake for fee waiver seats, if applicable, when the students were admitted to first semester level. Subsequent variations in intake shall have no bearing on the students eligible for branch change.
 - v. Maximum number of students permitted to change of branch shall be 25% of the students enrolled in the first year in the respective branch (s), subject to the strength of the class not decreasing below 75% of enrolled students and also not below 50% of intake approved by AICTE. After branch change the intake must not be more than approved AICTE intake including the fee waiver seats.

- vi. Branch change can be made only against clear vacancy in a particular branch, Vacancy (V) being defined as: V=I-(Reg+Rep+Lat)
 - where I = The prescribed intake for the branch including 10% intake for fee waiver seats.
 - Reg = No. of regular students who have been promoted & registered in third semester (including NRI & Management Quota seats)
 - Rep = No. of students from previous batches, registered in third semester as a regular students.
 - Lat = No. of students admitted & registered in third semester directly through lateral entry against vacant seats at first year level.
 - Branch Change shall not be permitted to any course where (Reg + Rep + Lat) > or = I under no circumstances, there shall be any exception to the above stipulations.
- vii. Branch Change shall be strictly according to the Merit list prepared by the college on the basis of total marks obtained by a student in First Year University Examination. Only those students who have passed in all the subjects (without any carry over paper or grace in any subject of any semester) shall be considered.
- viii. B.Tech. Biotechnology, B.Tech. Agriculture or Lateral Entry students shall not be eligible for branch change.
- ix. Students admitted on any seat which is over and above the AICTE sanctioned intake (such as Lateral entry, Kashmiri migrant) shall not be eligible for branch change.
- Change of Branch should be completed within 10 days of the declaration of First & Second Semester (First Year) result.
- xi. Excess intake in any branch shall disentitle the college to effectuate any branch change in that discipline until the punitive measure, such as reduction in intake etc. as imposed by Dr. APJ Abdul Kalam Technical University is effective.
- xii. College / students shall not be entitled to any relief, if the guidelines mentioned above for permitting branch change are not strictly adhered to.

RAGGING IS PUNISHABLE OFFENCE UNDER LAW

As per the orders of Hon'ble Supreme Court, AICTE, PCI, State Government and Dr. APJ Abdul Kalam Technical University, Ragging is illegal and completely prohibited and banned both inside and outside the college campus. A F.I.R. will be lodged against the student(s) involved in ragging if informed by victim student(s) or his/her parents/guardians.

As per Hon'ble Supreme Court of India's Order: "If any incident of ragging comes to the notice of the authority, the concerned student shall be given liberty to explain and if his/her explanation is not found satisfactory, the authority would expel him/her from the institution".

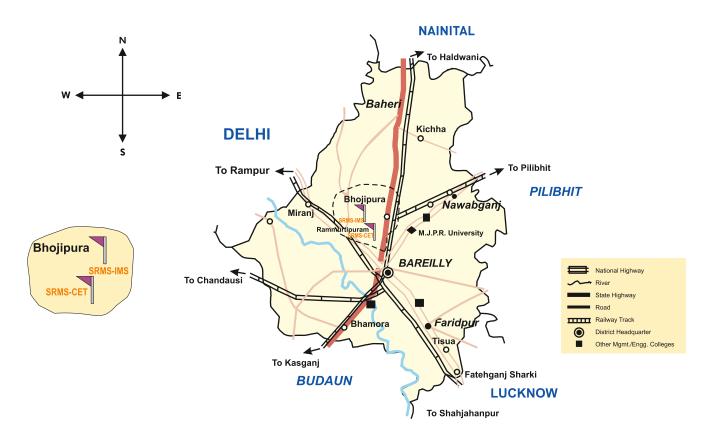
